Oh, I see.

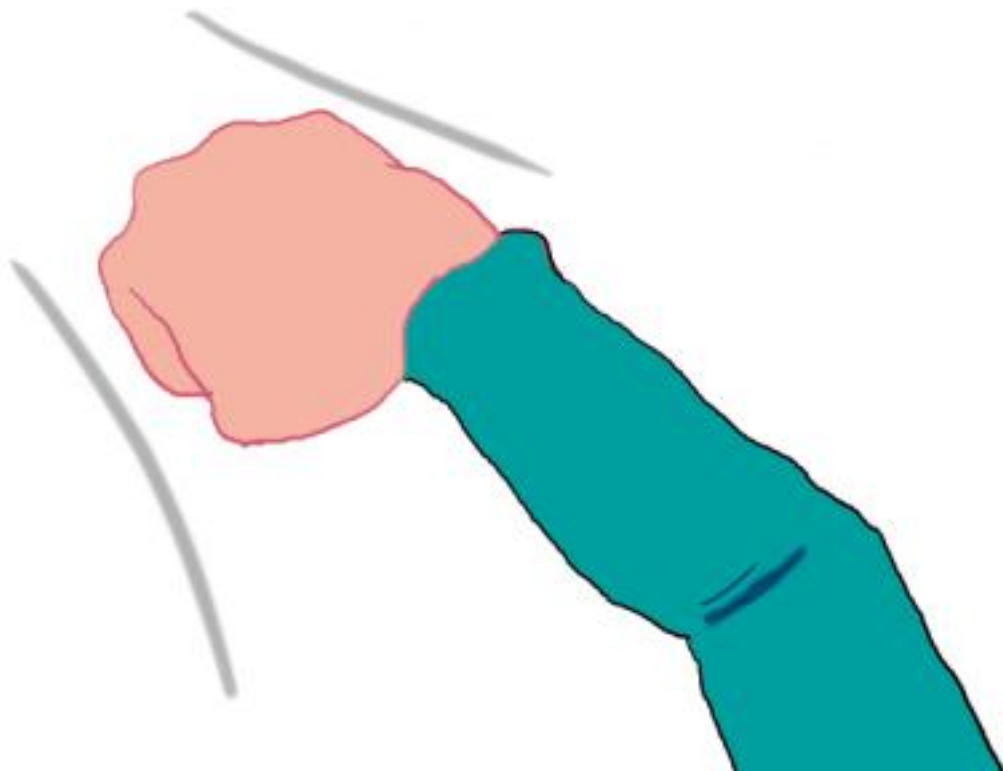
It seems everyone who attacks others believes they are serving justice.
